Program Summary: In 50 words or less describe your presentation. This will be the description used in the conference program.

Lead Presenter: Provide complete contact information for the program’s lead presenter includes the following:

- Name, institutional affiliation, primary mailing address, phone number, and primary email address.
- Presenter information must include highest relevant degree (e.g., MEd, MA, PhD, EdD, etc.), what the degree is in (e.g., counselor education, psychology, etc.), licenses held (e.g., PCC, PCC-S, PC, etc.), what the license is in (e.g., counseling, social work, psychology, etc.), and employment (e.g., Professor of Counselor Education, Clinical Counselor, etc.). ***Presenter information is necessary for CEUs.***

Co-Presenter(s): Provide complete contact information for each co-presenter includes the following:

- Name, institutional affiliation, primary mailing address, phone number, and primary email address.
- Presenter information must include highest relevant degree (e.g., MEd, MA, Ph.D, Ed.D, etc.), what the degree is in (e.g., counselor education, psychology, etc.), license(s) held (e.g., PC, PCC, PCC-S, etc.), what the license is in (e.g., counseling, social work, psychology, etc.), and employment (e.g., Professor of Counselor Education, Clinical Counselor, etc.). ***Presenter information is necessary for CEUs.***

Program Description: Provide a 200 word (max) synopsis of your program that includes the following:

- Summary of the information, technique, theory, or research to be presented;
- Type of presentation (lecture, round table discussion, panel discussion, etc.); and description of any accompanying audio-visual materials including handouts, reference lists, etc.

Program Objectives: Provide at least three learning objectives of the presentation.
